#### IV. Concurrent/Dual Course Placement/Statewide Minimum Exam Scores

High school students must have scored 19 or better on the ACT Reading sub-test, ASSET Reading score of 44 or better, COMPASS reading score of 83 or better <u>or</u> have a score on the EXPLORE, PLAN or PSAT assessments (see Table 1) that are projected to produce a 19 or better on the ACT Reading sub-test, or comparable score on the SAT, ASSET or COMPASS, to enroll in **any** general education course.

Enrollment in English Composition and mathematics courses also require a 19 or better on the respective ACT sub-test, ASSET Reading score of 44 or better, COMPASS reading score of 83 or better <u>or</u> a score on the EXPLORE, PLAN or PSAT assessments (see Table 1) that are projected to produce a 19 or better on the respective ACT sub-tests or comparable score on the SAT, COMPASS or ASSET.

Students who speak English as a second language must exhibit English competency as assessed by the ASSET or ACT.
