Articulation

Williams Baptist University (WBU), Arkansas State University-Jonesboro (ASUJ), Arkansas Tech University (ATU) and University of Arkansas Fort Smith (UAFS) have an articulation which will allow students seeking an Associate of Science in Criminal Justice from BRTC to transfer seamlessly. Students who earn the Associate of Science in Criminal Justice at BRTC will be admitted as a junior if all admission requirements are met. Courses may apply to other 4-year degrees as well.
